Subject: Regarding Parkisha Pe Charcha 2022.

The annual Pareeksha pe Charcha with Hon'ble PM is to be held on 1st April, 2022, from 10.00 am onwards. As you are aware, this is a programme that is highly popular with children and teachers wherein Hon'ble PM himself addresses the questions relating to exam anxiety, stress of studies, etc. raised by children from India and abroad.

All the Principals and Heads are hereby directed to ensure maximum participation of schools to facilitate real time viewing of the program by their school children and give personal attention to the matter for giving the benefit of this Charcha to maximum school going children in your schools.

The honourable Prime Minister will be interacting with the cross-section of students on 1 April 2022 where about 1000 school students will be participating in the programme. The PM's interaction will be with students from class 9 upwards and it will be broadcast live by Doordarshan (through DD national, DD news and DD India). It will also be available through live airing on radio channels (All India radio medium wave, All India radio FM channel). Live streaming on websites of PMO, MoE, Doordarshan, MyGov.in and YouTube channel of MoE, Facebook live and Swayam Prabha channels of MoE.

The Principals and Heads of all schools are here by directed to make necessary arrangements so that all the students from class 9 upwards in all the schools can view/hear the telecast.

Although most schools are equipped with TV and have electric connection, in case electricity, TV and reception of TV signal, (either through DTH satellite cable or aerial antenna) is not available or in the non-working condition in the school, then action to ensure that arrangements for TV and facility for TV reception (including making alternative arrangements for electricity that

day through generators/inverters etc)to ensure that students can view/ hear the Prime Minister's live address on that day may be taken in all schools.

Apart from the TV broadcast, the viewing facility may also be arranged through Edusat and also on internet access devices (computer/laptops/ mobile etc). The schools can utilize funds under the Samagra Shiksha for the purpose of hiring TVs if required and making necessary arrangements.

This must be given top priority. The school must upload create the login ID and Password on <https://www.mygov.in/ppc-2022/> and schools will upload atleast one photograph

Along with this, the open file of the PPC banner is attached along with this letter. The Principals and Heads are further directed to get the PPC banner displayed on the websites of the schools
